



Upon clearing customs at the airport or travelling across the Canadian border, tell the customs officer that you have **'goods to follow'**. Present the completed B4E document and your packing list. The officer will likely stamp these documents and give you a B15 form (landscape document with a blue border). Keep ALL these forms for final customs clearance after your shipment arrives.

Former resident means someone previously lived in Canada, moved abroad to live for at least 1 year and is now returning to live in Canada.

If you are a former Canadian resident, you only need to check off 1 OR 2, above.
